Aims of Training:



- The production capacity of entrepreneurs and farmers will be enhanced through skill development.
- Special attention is being given to research and development to increase bamboo production.
- To provide Bamboo farmers, local artisans and others working in the bamboo sector all benefits from such schemes.

Any financial help
from the government ?

- The government gives financial assistance for setting up new nursery for bamboo under this scheme.
- For setting up hi-tech nursery on 2 hectare land, the estimated cost is around 40 lakh per unit. 40 percent of the cost will be given by the government.
- At the same time, the estimated cost of small nursery is about 10 lakhs, out of which the government is giving 50 percent assistance
