INTRODUCTION

Odisha State Open University (OSOU), Odisha in collaboration with the Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia (CEMCA), New Delhi has developed a platform for acceptance of Open Educational Resources (OER) policy in the educational system of OSOU through both course writers and coordinators considering Self Learning Materials(SLM), video lectures and audio clips as the base for qualitative materials. In addition to it, incorporation of licensing process through Creative Commons will bring a new framework in the publication arena of the higher education system of India.

Outcomes of the Workshop:

After completion of the workshop, the participants will have:

- 1. Awareness about the basic theoretical concepts and practices related to OERs within institutional context.
- 2. Competencies associated with academic practices related to OER and open licenses.
- 3. Knowledge and skills in OER related functional areas including creation of quality assured course materials and search, find and reuse of OER materials to be integrated in course materials.
- 4. Awareness about the OSOU OER policy and its expectations from the academic staffs, course development teams and the tutorial teams.

- 1. Willingness to develop and implement OER related practises based on the OSOU OER
- 2. Policy adopted by the University.
- 3. Content expertise in any of the subject areas of OSOU courses.

INAUGURAL SESSION

At the outset, Dr. Jayant Ku. Sharma, Registrar, Odisha State Open University (OSOU), Odisha, the coordinator of the programme, welcomed all the guests and the participants of the workshop. He has outlined the need of organizing this workshop for the course developers and academicians. He has also described the objectives of the workshop. In addition to it, he has mentioned that the personal care and professional support received from CEMCA, New Delhi which has culminated into the transformation of the OER policy to be implemented in the curriculum of the university. This would be an exemplary message in the "International Open Access Week" as said by Dr. Sharma. In the inaugural session of the workshop, Dr. Prakash Ku. Pati, Dy. Director General, National Academy of Broadcasting and Multimedia (NABM), Bhubaneswar has attended as the Chief Guest, Prof. Mohan B. Menon, Ex-Assistant Vice Chancellor, Wawasan Open University, Malaysia and Education Specialist, CEMCA, New Delhi as the Key Resource Person and Dr. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi, Programme Officer, CEMCA, New Delhi as the Guest of Honour in the 3 (three) days workshop.

Prof. Menon inaugurated the workshop with the lamp lighting ceremony. In his inaugural speech, he stressed upon the growth and development of the Open Universities in India with a mandate to provide higher education to the left out students from the conventional method of education. Moreover, he has insisted that OER are learning materials that are freely available for use, remixing and redistributing with varied levels of licensing.

The participants were requested to introduce themselves. (The list of the participants is present in Appendix-2). At last, Mr. J. P. Mohapatra, Academic Consultant, Odisha State Open University, Odisha proposed the vote of thanks.

Workshop Proceedings

For achieving these learning outcomes, a workshop was held at National Academy of Broadcasting and Multimedia (NABM), Bhubaneswar, Odisha from 25-27 October 2016, on "Create and Repurpose of OER for learning" conducted by Prof. Mohan B. Menon, Ex-Assistant Vice Chancellor, Wawasan Open University, Malaysia and Education Specialist, CEMCA, New Delhi and Dr. Manas Ranjan Panigrahi, Programme Officer, CEMCA, New Delhi. Out of the total 28 participants, 12 were from different faculties of Odisha State Open University (OSOU) itself.

Day One:

In the 1st day of the workshop, Prof. Menon interacted with the participants to explore their expectations while differentiating between correspondence courses and Open and Distance Learning (ODL) courses. Subsequently, he has enumerated the historical development of Open Educational Resources (OER) from Open Courseware of Massachusetts Institute of Technology

(MIT), USA to the present situation of development. He has discussed the flexibility in the framework of OER Licensing Policy based on 04 conditions i.e. Attribution, Non – Commercial, Non – Derivatives and Share Alike, which is going to take over the traditional policy of Copyright and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR). He has also questioned to the participants that what has enabled OER? In reply of it, he has mentioned some implications i.e. socially, it has brought changes in philosophy; technically, affordable to the internet; financially, a range of financial models; legally, alternative to copyright licensing. In the last session, Dr. Sharma, Registrar, OSOU has described the mandate of the university and OER licensing policy (CC – BY - SA) which has been newly developed to be incorporated in the coming structure of Self Learning Materials (SLM) and allied activities.

Day II:

In the 2^{nd} day of the workshop, Dr. Panigrahi explained the four quadrants of e-learning as the TIPS framework for the teachers as creators of OER elaborating: Teaching and learning processes, Information and material content, Presentation product and format and finally, System technical and technology. He has suggested that a single licensing system to be acquired by different universities of the state, having conventional method of teaching and ODL system, creating a perfect form of blended learning within the parameters of educational norms. Moreover, the fundamental mission of the open education, namely, reaching the unreached should not be dissociated from the public domain. He has also suggested that ODL system should be summed up as 3A - anyone, anytime, $anywhere\ learning$ having learning materials with higher degree of consistency promoting a sense of connectivity among learners pursuing the distance mode of education.

Day III:

On the final day, Dr. Panigrahi explained the strategic plan and action plan lucidly to be adhered by the course developers of the university. Further, teams were divided with their topics to be presented before the forum for better clarification and development while framing the study materials. Before the conclusion the participants expressed their satisfaction regarding hospitality provided to them in Bhubaneswar.

VALEDICTORY SESSION

Valedictory ceremony was held at 5.30 pm on 27th October, 2016.
