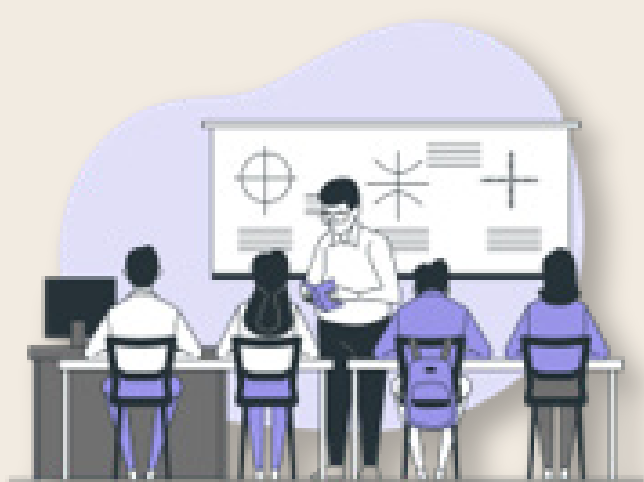


Components of Learning

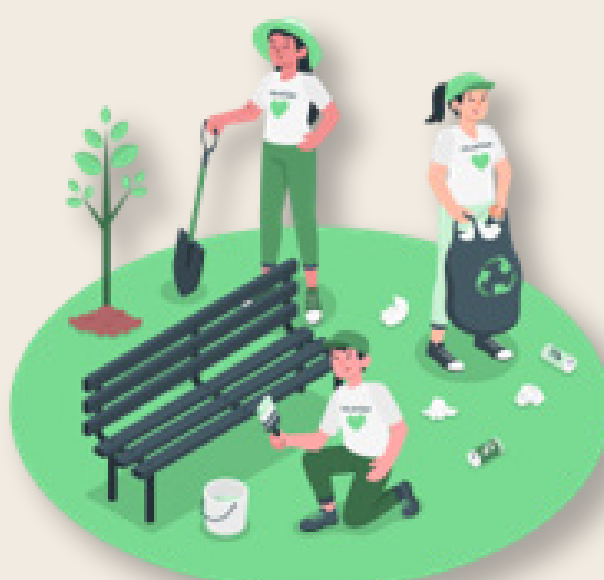
