Minor Stream

Aside from disciplinary/ interdisciplinary minors, students will be able to choose courses that are relevant to their selected vocational education programme.



Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)

These courses seek to educate students basic linguistic abilities such as critical reading, expository and academic writing, allowing them to articulate thoughts and present their viewpoints clearly.



Value Added Courses common for all UG

Courses such as Understanding India, Environmental Science/ Education, Digital and Technological Solutions, Health & Wellness, Yoga Education, Sports and Fitness or any other course innovatively designed by the HEI can be offered



Research Project/ **Dissertation**

Students pursuing a 4-Year Bachelor's degree (Honours with Research) undertake research projects under faculty guidance with outcomes potentially published, presented, or patented.

Major (Core)

The major allows a student to delve deeply into specific subject or discipline.



Multidisciplinary

These courses are part of the liberal arts and science curriculum and are meant to expand one's intellectual horizons.



Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)

These courses are designed to improve students' employability by imparting soft skills, practical expertise, and hands-on training.

It offers students practical learning opportunities, including internships, apprenticeships, community engagement, and field-based projects, enhancing their employability and understanding of socioeconomic issues.
