CRITERION-BASED GRADING **OUTCOME-BASED ASSESSMENT**

Continuous and comprehensive evaluation Criterion-based grading system emphasizes embraces horizontal assessment modes instead of one single vertical mode.

assessment of student achievement based on the learning goals for each programme.

Outcome based assessment provides clear picture of what is important for students to be able to do.

It can be used to assess the overall development of students.

A criterion defines the characteristics or traits to be judged. These are derived from the learning outcomes.

It is necessary to assess modern skills and domain-specific competencies.

For example: critical thinking, problemsolving ability, right application of knowledge, and adherence to ethics.

Grading can be designed to measure the degree of achievement on each criterion thus making assessments more meaningful.

It ensures that evaluation is more students centric.
